Associate Professor Myers was appointed as the Program Director for Medical Imaging at AIMSS in 2016. During his career he has contributed to a broad range of research projects including the study of metabolic bone disease and bone lytic tumours through to complex imaging studies in epilepsy, and for investigation of traumatic brain injury. Other interests include regenerative medicine and utilisation of stem cells in tissue engineering. He is renowned for his expertise in clinical imaging techniques and application of advanced imaging in research and translational medicine.

This AIMSS seminar will highlight how imaging technologies have been developed for medical diagnoses and investigation of disease processes. The aim of this seminar is to relate advanced medical imaging capabilities that have informed us about the musculoskeletal system and, as will be discussed, imaging modalities relevant to the AIMSS platform.
