Professor Bente Langdahl is a consultant at the department of Endocrinology and internal medicine at Aarhus University Hospital, and Professor at Aarhus University, Denmark.

Professor Langdahl is an international osteoporosis expert and will review the latest research in the field of osteoporosis with specific reference to treatment choices for the re-fracturing patient.

Her research interests include identification and investigation of genetic variants that imply increased risk of osteoporotic fractures, osteogenesis imperfecta in adult patients, interactions between fat and bone tissues, the impact of thyroid diseases and diabetes on bone health, the effects of vitamin D and K on bone, and the development of new treatments for osteoporosis.

Prof Langdahl is co-chair for the Internal Federation of Musculoskeletal Research Society (IFMRS), and past president of the European Calcified Tissue Society (ECTS).
