Mattias Lorentzon is a professor and consulting physician in geriatric medicine. He recently relocated from the University of Gothenburg in Sweden to commence a position as Program Leader for the Bone Health and Fractures Research Program at the Australian Catholic University (ACU) in Melbourne. He also holds an honorary position at AIMSS, where he will perform clinical studies investigating the effect of nutritional and probiotic supplements on bone metabolism. His research topics include bone microstructure and fracture risk, probiotics and bone, as well as frailty and fracture risk in the elderly.
